



## **University preparatory course (Studienkolleg)**

Foreign and German medical school applicants, who do not have a secondary school-leaving certificate qualifying for university admission and who are entitled to directly enter the medical program, must take an entrance examination to determine the suitability of foreign applicants for admission to a course of studies at a university in the Federal Republic of Germany. This entrance examination can either be taken right away or after a one-year preparatory course. There are several main preparatory courses. At the Charité, you can apply for the main preparatory course M. Once you have passed the entrance examination, you will receive a qualifying certificate for university admission restricted to medicine, dentistry, biology, pharmacy.

### **Application deadlines**

#### **University preparatory course (Course M)**

April 15<sup>th</sup> for the following winter semester – external exam

Mai 31<sup>th</sup> for the following winter semester

October 15<sup>th</sup> for the following summer semester

The following documents should be submitted with the application for the university preparatory course, course M:

- Notarized copies of all school certificates
- Notarized copy of the German language certificate (see Common European Framework of Reference for Languages)
- Translation of all certificates into German (exception: certificates in English) submitted as notarized copies

Copies of all submitted documents must be notarized. The correctness of the German translations must be certified by the responsible German diplomatic or consular representative in the country of origin or by an interpreter or translator in the Federal Republic of Germany.

Applicants to the **university preparatory course** must have a language certificate demonstrating proficiency in German at the **intermediate level 1 or B2** or higher.

*Certificates of attendance at a German language course are not accepted.*
