Cardiac amyloidoses: pathophysiology, diagnosis and advances in the management

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Cardiac Amyloidoses represent a major challenge in cardiology, still characterised by an unacceptably high mortality. Late diagnosis contributes dramatically to such a dismal outcome. When dealing with rare diseases, the contribution of referral centers and networks may be very important to foster awareness, timely diagnosis and treatment. Since Pavia (Italy) represents one of the leading centers in the study of systemic amyloidoses, the meeting will focus on up-to-date diagnosis, treatment and pathophysiological insights in the intriguing and challenging realm of cardiac deposition of amyloid fibrils, firstly described by Rudolf Virchow.
